

WORDING FOR CLAIMS FOR LOST TIME WHILE IN FEDERAL REST

Claim must be worded as shown below with all known information. Submit claim to timekeeping, upon decline, submit to your Local Chairman a copy of claim, copy of pay slip with appropriate decline number, showing your total pay received for the half, and any other documentation you might have to prove your claim.

EXTRA BOARD:

Claim is submitted without prejudice to the Organizations position that the violation involved constitutes a major dispute under the Railway Labor Act.

Claim is for monetary shortage of paid guarantee and/or the Bonus Day Payment for the below listed pay period. I was marked up and available the entire pay period in OK status except when placed in FR statues while obtaining federally required rest under the Law.

I was not unavailable at any time during this pay period of my own accord, but I was docked guarantee and/or my mark up bonus while placed in FR status.

POOL TURNS:

Claim is submitted without prejudice to the Organizations position that the violation involved constitutes a major dispute under the Railway Labor Act.

Claim is for payment of one (1) round trip lost, including all arbitraries and trip credits if applicable, account mishandling of regular assigned pool turn by CMS Crew Dispatcher. On (date) Conductor (initials and last name) tied up after working my regular assigned turn at the Home Terminal, I had worked six (6) straight starts and was placed in FR statues for forty-eight hours as required by Law. When my regular assigned turn reached first out instead of my turn being held first out for my rest CMS called an Extra Man and ran my turn out causing me to miss out on an entire round trip.
